County," sub-title "County Commissioners," to come in after section twenty-two, and be known as section 22 A, to read as follows:

SEC. 22 A. Whenever they deem it necessary the County Commissioners may, on or before the first day of May in each Keeper of year, appoint some person as keeper of the standards of weights and measures for the county, who shall safely keep and preserve said standards, and when required shall deliver them to the County Commissioners, or to such person as they may appoint to receive the same, and who shall perform the several duties of his office prescribed by law.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That all acts or parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act be and the same Repeal. are hereby repealed, in so far as they relate to Carroll county, and that this act shall take effect from the date of its effective. passage.

CHAPTER 110.

AN ACT to add a new section to Article seventy of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Official Oaths," regulating the administration of the oath or affirmation of office, prescribed by the Constitution, to District School Trustees, to be designated as Section 5 A, and to follow Section 5 of said Article.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That a new section be and the same is hereby New section. added to article seventy of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Official Oaths," to be designated as section 5 A, to follow section 5, and to read as follows:

5 A. District school trustees shall take and subscribe the oath or affirmation of office prescribed by the Coustitution, before Oath of district school the county school commissioner and examiner or a justice of trustees. the peace, in their respective counties.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect Effective.
