Pearre, the sum of four thousand seven hundred and fifty dollars, improperly paid by them into the treasury of the State, as bondsmen of J. Graham Pearre.

CHAPTER 146.

AN ACT to incorporate the Towson Water Company.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That William A. Hanway, G. Herbert Rice, John A body cor-I. Yellott, Milton W. Offutt, John B. Longnecker, David G. McIntosh, John Ridgely, of H., Robert R. Boarman and William H. Ruby, and their successors, be and they are hereby constituted a body corporate and politic under the name and style of the "Towson Water Company," and by that name shall have perpetual succession.
