He shall prescribe to an oath for the faithful performance of his duties, and give bond to the State of Maryland in the penal sum of one thousand dollars, to be approved by the commissioners, conditional for the faithful performance of his duties.

Duties of treasurer.

68 A. The treasurer shall receive all money that may be collected for taxes, fees, fines or otherwise, by any law or ordinance, directly or through the bailiff, collector, clerk or police justice, and credit each item under separate heads, and shall deposit the same in some safe bank to the credit of the commissioners of Cristield, and make quarterly reports, and all such moneys shall be paid out by order of the commissioners, and countersigned by said treasurer and president of the board; he shall subscribe to an oath for the faithful performance of his duties, and give bond to the State of Maryland in the sum of two thousand dollars, to be approved by the commissioners, conditional for the faithful performance of his duties, and his books shall be subject to inspection by any taxpayer.

68 B. Every bailiff before entering upon his duties shall subscribe to an oath for the faithful performance of his duties Oath of bailiff. for the enforcement of the ordinances of the town and the preservation of its peace and good order. He shall be vested with all the civil and police powers of a constable of Crisfield district, and any one resisting him in the discharge of his duties shall be liable upon conviction to punishment in the same manner and to the same extent as if he had resisted a constable; and he shall perform all such other duties as are Duties. or shall be imposed upon him by law, ordinance, or by order of the commissioners; and he shall pay over all fines or fees
