

CHAPTER 316.

AN ACT for the assistance of the Home for the Aged of Frederick City.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Treasurer, on the warrant of the Comptroller, be and he is hereby authorized and directed to pay to the order of the treasurer of the Board of Trustees of the Home for the Aged of Frederick city, the sum of three thousand dollars, to be used in repairing, furnishing and in maintaining the same as a home for destitute and aged persons, in accordance with the rules and regulations which said corporation has established, and said sum shall be payable as follows, viz: one thousand five hundred dollars in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-four, and one thousand five hundred in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-five.

Appropriation.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 317.

AN ACT to amend Article one hundred of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Work, Hours of, in Factories," by adding thereto a section, to be known as Section 4, regulating the employment of children under twelve years of age, in mills and factories in this State.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That article one hundred of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, be amended by adding thereto the following section, to come in immediately after section three of said article, and to be known as section four.

New section.

SEC. 4. No proprietor or owner of any mill or factory in this State, other than establishments for manufacturing canned goods, or manager, agent, foreman or other person in charge thereof, shall, after the first day of October in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-four, employ or retain in employment in any such mill or factory, any person or persons under twelve

Employing children under 12 years of age.
