*First.* To the bequest of one hundred dollars to the pastor of Mount Saint Mary's College Church, in Frederick county, Maryland, as contained in the last will and testament of Mary C. Dielman, late of Frederick county, Maryland, deceased, as recorded in record of wills, H. L. No. 1, folio 509 and 510, in the office of the register of wills of Frederick county, Maryland.
