Forty-third. To the deed from the "East New Market Female Seminary," a body corporate by virtue of chapter 533 of the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of 1849, to the Convention of the Protestant Episcopal Church in the Diocese of Easton, a body corporate under the laws of Maryland, of a lot of ground situated in the second election district of Dorchester county, Maryland, and in the town of East New Market, which is described as follows: Beginning for the same on the west side of the county road or street leading to 'Cabin creek, at a stone on the northeast corner of the lot belonging to Fred Wright, and running thence north seventy-one degrees, west two hundred and fifty six feet, by and with the line of said Fred Wright; thence north twenty-one degrees, east eighty-three feet, by and with the line of Samuel L.
