316 A. In all wills hereafter executed, the real estate of every testator not specifically devised shall be chargeable with the payment of pecuniary legacies, wherever the personal estate, after the payment of debts, shall prove to be insufficient, unless the contrary intention shall clearly appear. Payment of pecuniary legacies.

CHAPTER 439.

AN ACT to prohibit the laying of railway tracks upon a portion of North Caroline street, in the city of Baltimore, without the consent of the General Assembly.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That it shall not be lawful for any person or corporation to lay any railway tracks upon North Caroline street, between Preston street and East North avenue, without the consent of the General Assembly of Maryland; provided, that this act shall not restrict in any way the right of any passenger railway now incorporated, or that may hereafter be incorporated, to cross said street, where such railway company shall be authorized by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to use any street or avenue opening into said street. Where unlawful to lay tracks.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect Effective. from the date of its passage.

AN ACT to amend the Act of eighteen hundred and sixty, Chapter nineteen, entitled "An Act to Incorporate the Egerton Orphan Asylum of Baltimore."
