

persons may be licensed to sell spirituous or fermented liquors within the limits of the town of Cambridge, in Dorchester county, shall be submitted to the qualified voters of said town, as qualified by law to vote at the municipal elections thereof, on the fourth Tuesday in May next, which election shall be held at the court house in said town, between the hours of eight o'clock A. M. and six o'clock P. M., during which time the polls shall be kept open by the judges of election.

Question to be voted on.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the town commissioners of said town shall and they are hereby directed to give notice of said election, by advertisement inserted once in each of three successive weeks prior to the day of election, in the Cambridge Chronicle, The Democrat and News, and the Dorchester Era, newspapers of said town, and shall, at least ten days prior to said election, appoint three judges thereof, who shall in turn, prior to or on the day of election, appoint two clerks of election, and hold the election as herein provided, the said judges and clerks of election first qualifying themselves to act as such, after the manner of other judges and clerks of election, as now provided by law.

Notice of election.

Judges and clerks.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the ballots cast at said election shall have written or printed upon them the words, "For the sale of Spirituous or Fermented Liquors" or "Against the sale of Spirituous or Fermented Liquors," and that the ballots so cast shall be carefully counted by the said judges of election, and that said judges shall make a return of such vote to the Commissioners of Cambridge; and if it appears that a majority of the ballots so cast shall contain the words "For the sale of Spirituous or Fermented Liquors," written or printed upon them, then the said commissioner shall forthwith make proclamation of the result of the election, by advertisement thereof, at least once in each of the newspapers aforesaid; and on and after the second day of July next, it shall be lawful for all persons to sell spirituous or fermented liquors within the limits of said town, under the restrictions and provisions hereinafter contained; and sections 207 to 213, inclusive, of article 10, Code of Public Local Laws, shall be and they are hereby repealed so far as the limits of said town of Cambridge may be affected thereby.

Ballots.

If vote be for sale.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That it shall not be lawful for any person or persons to sell spirituous or fermented liquors in the said town of Cambridge, until he or they shall first comply with the following provisions:
