

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That said school house shall be erected under the supervision and control of the school commissioners for said county, and the site or location for said school house shall be determined by said school commissioners. Where to be built.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.

CHAPTER 552.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money as compensation to Harrison W. Vickers for professional services in the case of the State of Maryland vs. Fletcher Williams and others.

WHEREAS, Harrison W. Vickers was appointed special counsel for the State in the case of the State against Fletcher Williams and eight others, for the murder of Dr. James Heigh Hill, late of Kent county, and has not been compensated for his professional services. Preamble.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Treasurer, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, this claim having previously received the sanction and recommendation of the Comptroller, is hereby directed to pay to Harrison W. Vickers, as compensation in the case of the State vs. Fletcher Williams and others, the sum of six hundred dollars, to be paid out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated. Appropriation.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.

CHAPTER 553.

AN ACT to prohibit the trapping, capturing, shooting or otherwise killing or injuring of quail within Worcester County for one year.
