CHAPTER 65.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments, Section 26 A of Article nineteen of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "St. Mary's County," sub-title "County Commissioners," as said section was enacted by Chapter 669 of the Acts of Assembly of 1892.

Repeal.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section 26 A of article nineteen of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "St. Mary's County," sub-title "County Commissioners," as said section was enacted by chapter 669 of the Acts of Assembly of 1892, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Meetings of County Con missioners. 26 a. The said commissioners shall hold their meetings at Leonardtown, on the second Tuesday in each and every month of the year, and oftener, if in their judgment the public interest shall require it, and they shall receive as compensation for their services, the sum of three dollars and mileage each for every meeting which they shall attend.
