CHAPTER 631.

AN ACT to add additional sections to Article three of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, titled "Baltimore County," sub-titled "Circuit Court," to follow section eighteen of said Article, and to be known as sections 18 A, 18 B, 18 c, 18 p, 18 E, 18 F, 18 G, 18 H, 18 I, 18 K and 18 L.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the following sections be added to article New sections. three of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, titled "Baltimore County," sub-titled "Circuit Court," to follow section 18 of said Article, and to be known as sections 18 A, 18 B, 18c, 18d, 18e, 18f, 18g, 18h, 18i, 18k and 18L

18 A. In addition to the first day of each term of the Circuit Court for said county, the first Monday in February, the Return days. second Monday in April and the third Monday in July, the third Monday in October of each year, shall be return days for the return of processes in civil cases.

18 B.
