SEC. 4. And be it further enacted, That it shall Constables to be the duty of the constables of the several election districts of said county to arrest any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this act and take them before the nearest justice of the peace, to be dealt with as this act has heretofore directed.

SEC. 5. And be it further enacted, That after the payment of one-half of all fines which may Fines-how disposed of. be collected under the provisions of any or all of the sections of this act to the informer, the remainder shall be paid by the justice of the peace collecting the same to the county school commissioners of said county for the benefit of the public schools thereof.

SEC. 6. And be it further enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
