

to whomsoever he wishes, said invitation to be in writing, signed by the land owner.

Constables to arrest. SEC. 4. *And be it further enacted*, That it shall be the duty of the constables of the several election districts of said county to arrest any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this act and take them before the nearest justice of the peace, to be dealt with as this act has heretofore directed.

Fines—how disposed of. SEC. 5. *And be it further enacted*, That after the payment of one-half of all fines which may be collected under the provisions of any or all of the sections of this act to the informer, the remainder shall be paid by the justice of the peace collecting the same to the county school commissioners of said county for the benefit of the public schools thereof.

Effective. SEC. 6. *And be it further enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 91.

AN ACT to authorize the Governor of Maryland to appoint a notary public in the town of Middletown, in Frederick county, Maryland.

Appoint notary public. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the governor of said state be and he is hereby authorized to appoint a notary public in Middletown, in Frederick county, Maryland.

Effective. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
