

cents in the hundred dollars; provided the said county commissioners, after fully investigating and inquiring into the demands and needs of said special tax for the purposes of said road in said road district, as set forth in said petition, shall determine said special tax to be necessary and for the best interest of the people in said district, and said tax to be expended under the directions of the said commissioners within said district; and it shall be the duty of the collector of county taxes to collect the same, and his bond shall be responsible therefor; and the said taxes shall be collected with the other taxes of the county, but a separate account kept of the same; and the expense of collecting said special tax shall be levied upon and paid by the assessable property in said road district. Who to collect

SEC. 13. *And be it enacted*, That all laws inconsistent with this act be and the same are hereby repealed. Inconsistent laws repealed.

SEC. 14. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the day of its passage. Effective.

Chapter 97.

AN ACT to enlarge the powers of the Lake Chrome and Mineral Company of Baltimore county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Lake Chrome and Mineral Company of Baltimore county, incorporated under the twenty-sixth article of the Code of Public General Laws of the State of Maryland, adopted by the general assembly at its session, January, eighteen hundred and sixty, shall have power to make assessments on the holders of its shares of stock for the purpose of raising money to improve its property and erect necessary additional machinery, buildings and other improvements and appliances for the purpose.
