

Chapter 99.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments chapter two hundred and fifty-three of the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, January session of eighteen hundred and sixty-two, entitled "An act to incorporate the German Reformed Church of Manchester, Carroll county."

Repealed and re-enacted. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That chapter two hundred and fifty-three of the acts of eighteen hundred and sixty-two, entitled "An act to incorporate the German Reformed Church of Manchester, Carroll county," be and the same is hereby repealed, and re-enacted as follows :

Created a body politic. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That Jacob O. Baltozer, Edward E. Sellers, Charles Brilhart, William Kealer, John W. Burns, Willoughby E. F. Rhoades, Michael M. Wilhelm and Edwin H. I. Rhoades, trustees, and their successors in office elected agreeably to the rules, by-laws and regulations of said church or congregation, shall be and they are hereby created and declared to be a body politic and corporate by the name, style and title of the Trinity Reformed Church of Manchester, Carroll county ; and by the said name shall be able to sue and be sued, implead and be impleaded in any court of law or equity in this state or elsewhere, and to make and have a common seal, and the same to break, alter or renew at pleasure ; and also to make and establish such by-laws and ordinances as may be necessary for regulating the temporal concerns of said church.

Lands and tenements— who vested in. SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That all lands and tenements, with their appurtenances, vested in the trustees for the use of the said church, and all other property of the said church, shall be and are hereby absolutely and unconditionally vested in the said body corporate and their successors forever. And the said corporation shall be and they are hereby declared to be capable, as corporate body, of bargaining and selling, leasing and conveying any part of their said
