## Chapter 101.

AN ACT to give and grant the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland to the sale and conveyance by Robert Oliver, to the First Independent church of Baltimore, of certain property on the northwest side of Belair avenue, in the city of Baltimore.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the sanction and consent of said general assembly be and is hereby granted and given to the sale, by Robert Oliver, consent given. to the First Independent church of Baltimore, of certain property on the northwest side of Belair avenue, in the city of Baltimore, and fully described in a deed dated August twenty-second, eighteen hundred and twenty-one, and now recorded among the land records of Baltimore city, in liber W. G., number one hundred and sixty, folio seven hundred and seventeen, from said Oliver to the First Independent church of Baltimore.
