Assembly of Maryland passed at the session of the year eighteen hundred and eighty-two, as amended by chapter fifty-two of the acts of assembly passed at the session of eighteen hundred and eighty-four, relating to the protection of rabbits and partridges, and to permit the shooting of ducks and other wild fowl from shore over decoys; also to pay a bounty upon heads of hawks and large owls in Kent county, and to reenact the same as follows, be and the same are hereby repealed.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That chapter five hundred and How far reseven of the acts of assembly passed at the January session, eighteen hundred and eighty-six, entitled an act to add additional sub-section to article fifty-six of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "License," be and the same is hereby repealed so far as the same applies to Garrett county.
