Chapter 111.

AN ACT to repeal and to re-enact with amendments section two of article four of the Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "City of Baltimore."

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section two of article Repealed and four of the Public Local Laws of Maryland, title re-cnacted. "City of Baltimore," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

2. All the property and funds of every kind belonging to or in possession of the city of Baltimore are vested in the said corporation; and vested in. the said corporation may receive in trust, and may control for the purpose of such trusts, all money or other property which may have been or shall be bestowed upon such corporation by will, deed, or in any other form of gift or conveyance, in trust for any general corporate purpose, or in aid of the indigent and poor, or for the general purposes of education, or for charitable purpose of any description within the said city; and the said corporation may sell or lease, Power to sell or make such other disposition as it may seem best, of any property belonging to the said corporation.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Effective. act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
