

Chapter 124.

AN ACT to repeal sections three and five of chapter twenty-eight of the acts of eighteen hundred and forty-one, entitled a supplement to an act entitled "An act to incorporate a company to make a turnpike road from Boonsborough, in Washington county, to Swearingen's Ferry," on the Potomac river, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Repealed and re-enacted.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That sections three and five of chapter twenty-eight of the acts of eighteen hundred and forty-one be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted to read as follows :

Publish verified statement

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That, annually hereafter, between the first of March and the tenth of May, the president and managers aforesaid shall publish in some newspaper in Washington county a statement, verified by the affidavit of the secretary, of all the receipts and disbursements of the said company between the date of the last published statement and the date of the one then made, and also of the annual dividend of said company.

Give public notice.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted,* That hereafter notice shall be given of the time and place of the annual election for officers of said company by public advertisement, inserted in some newspaper in Washington county, at Hagerstown, for three successive weeks prior to said election, and that notice shall be given of the election of the officers by one advertisement in said paper.

Effective.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from its passage.
