

said corporation, of such lot or lots of ground on or near to Park avenue in the city of Baltimore, as their needs as a religious society may require, and it is hereby permitted and authorized to buy, receive, hold, lease, mortgage, or sell such lot or lots as may be desirable, or the interests of said corporation as a religious society may require, in all respects as an individual or natural person might do.

Effective.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 130.

AN ACT to prevent non-residents of the State of Maryland from fishing or hunting in Garrett county without permission, in writing, from the owner of the premises upon which such hunting or fishing is done, and to prevent any person from fishing in Bear creek in said county for two years.

Written permission to hunt or fish.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That any person not a *bona fide* resident of the State of Maryland, who shall fish or hunt in Garrett county, without the written permission of the owner of the premises upon which he so fishes or hunts, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

When to fish.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That any person who shall fish in Bear creek, in Garrett county, before the first day of April, eighteen hundred and ninety, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Penalty.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That any person convicted before a tribunal having jurisdiction of a violation of section one and two of this act shall be fined not less than ten nor more than fifty dollars, one-half to the informer and the other half to school commissioners.

Effective.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
