

Chapter 148.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the Peoples' Railway Company by reducing the par value of the shares of its capital stock.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the par value of the shares of the capital stock of the Peoples' Railway Company be reduced to twenty dollars per share, and that such number of shares of such reduced value shall be issued to the present holders of the capital stock of said company as will be equal to the amount of capital stock now held by them. Reduce par value of shares

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.

Chapter 149.

AN ACT for the further protection of partridges and quail in Worcester and Wicomico counties.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That no person, corporation or company, shall at any time kill, or expose for sale, transport or have in possession, any partridge or quail, after the same has been killed for any purpose except for consumption as food, within Worcester or Wicomico counties, nor kill, expose for sale, or have in possession, any of the above-named game with the intention of sending, or transporting, or having the same sent or transported beyond the limits of said counties; provided, that nothing herein shall prevent the barter or sale of such game for home consumption only by residents of said counties within the limits of said counties. What not to kill.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this How construed.
