

and proceed therewith without delay to execute his duty under such warrant. The justice before whom such offender or offenders shall be taken shall have full power to issue summons for all witnesses that be named to him, to compel their appearance and examine them under oath.

Inconsistencies repealed.

SEC. 9. *And be it enacted*, That all acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act be and the same are hereby repealed, and that this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 152.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the Mutual Life Insurance Company of Baltimore, as incorporated by chapter two hundred and seventy-six of the acts of assembly passed at the January session of the year eighteen hundred and fifty-eight, and chapter thirty-three of the acts of assembly, eighteen hundred and seventy.

Who is entitled to vote.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That any member of the Mutual Life Insurance Company of Baltimore, who shall be such by virtue of a policy for not less than one thousand dollars, issued not less than one year before the election of any director or directors of said company, shall be entitled to vote at such election, and no other members or other persons shall be so entitled; members entitled to vote, may vote either personally or by proxy, provided that the proxy shall conform to the by-laws of the said company.

Directors—how elected.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That at the next ensuing annual meeting of the Mutual Life Insurance Company of Baltimore, after this act shall have become law, the members of the said company so as aforesaid entitled to vote at the election of directors shall elect two direc-
