

Who to levy. necessary to make repairs on said roads, the road commissioners shall have power to cause such repairs to be made as in their judgment may be required, and the county commissioners shall levy such amount as may be sufficient, to pay for such repairs, at the annual meeting, to make the levy for county taxes upon the order of said road commissioners.

Per diem. SEC. 10. *And be it enacted*, That the said road commissioners shall each receive from the county commissioners the sum of one dollar and a half for each day he is engaged in performing the duties of his office.

Who to constitute board. SEC. 11. *And be it enacted*, That until the first election for road commissioners as herein provided for, and the qualification of the officers then elected, A. S. Leathering, J. W. Shemwell, Dr. T. M. Chaney, be and they are hereby appointed a board of road commissioners of Calvert county, with power and authority to do and perform all acts and things that said road commissioners to be elected as herein provided for are authorized and empowered by this act to do and perform.

Inconsistencies repealed. SEC. 12. *And be it enacted*, That all acts inconsistent with this act be and the same are hereby repealed.

Effective. SEC. 13. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

### Chapter 161.

AN ACT for the preservation of birds and game in Montgomery county.

What unlawful to kill. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That it shall not be lawful to kill any robin, blue bird, thrush, martin, mocking bird, barn swallow, mason swallow, lark, oriole, red bird, cat bird, chipping or summer sparrow, wren, pewitt, goldfinch, sap-sucker, hanging bird, woodpecker, fly catcher and tana-
