## Chapter 162.

AN ACT to empower the county commissioners of St. Mary's county to levy a sum of money. for the building of a school-house for white children in Foster's neck, in St. Marv's county.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the county commis-Levy to build school-house. sioners of St. Mary's county be and they are hereby empowered and directed to levy for the building of a school-house for white children, in Foster's neck, in St. Mary's county, such a sum of money as in the opinion of the said commissioners may be sufficient for the purpose hereinbefore specified.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall Effective. take effect from the date of its passage.

## Chapter 163.

AN ACT to repeal sections twenty-two and twenty-three of article twenty-eight of the Code of Public General Laws, title "County Commissioners," sub-title "Public Roads." sofar as the same relate to Howard county, and also to add two additional sections to the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Howard County."

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That sections twenty-two and twenty-three of article twenty-eight of the How far re-Code of Public General Laws, title "County Commissioners," sub-title "Public Roads," be and the same are hereby repealed so far as they relate to Howard county, and that two additional sections be and the same are hereby added to the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Howard County," to read as follows:
