SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 23.

AN ACT to appropriate the sum of one thousand five hundred and forty-one dollars and seventy-nine cents out of the public school funds to reimburse Garrett county for an installment of the state school tax withheld from said county in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-seven; and, also, to authorize and direct the comptroller to apportion to said county the installment known as the "April installment of the state school tax for the year eighteen hundred and eighty-eight," said installment being the apportionment made to said Garrett county on the fifteenth day of March in each year.

Preamble.

WHEREAS, an installment of the state school tax, amounting to the sum of one thousand five-hundred and forty-one dollars and seventy-nine cents was withheld from Garrett county in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, and said county not having been able to keep its schools open seven and a-half months in the
