

SEC. 15. *And be it enacted*, That this corporation shall have full power to rescind or revoke any policy or contract of insurance, by them issued, whenever they shall deem it for the interest of said company to do so. Rescind or re-
voke policy.

SEC. 16. *And be it enacted*, That all and every of the members of this company who shall sustain any loss or damage by fire, shall give notice to the president and directors of the company at their office, to the end that the directors, their officers or agent, may examine and inquire into the same. Give notice of
loss.

SEC. 17. *And be it enacted*, That no policy or contract of insurance shall be issued by the said company until an amount of property, equal to the value of fifty thousand dollars, is offered and contracted to be insured. Policy—how
issued.

SEC. 18. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.

Chapter 171.

AN ACT to incorporate the Ancient Order of Hibernians in the State of Maryland.

WHEREAS an association exists in the State of Maryland under the title of the Ancient Order of Hibernians; and whereas said association has applied for an act of incorporation in order that thereby its existence may be rendered more secure, and that it may be enabled to carry out with greater efficiency the important objects for which it was formed; therefore, Preamble.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Maryland*, That Michael Murphy, John Flannigan, Michael Reilly, William Broderick, John T. Gannon, Michael Morgan, Joseph Loughlin, John Cavan, Daniel Sweeney, James Stackem, John Chambers and Michael I. Malamphy, and such other persons as are now members of said association in the State of Maryland, and their successors, be and Created a cor-
poration.
