SEC. 15. And be it enacted, That this corporation shall have full power to rescind or revoke any Rescind or repolicy or contract of insurance, by them issued, voke policy. whenever they shall deem it for the interest of said company to do so.

Sec. 16. And be it enacted. That all and every of the members of this company who shall sus- Give notice of tain any loss or damage by fire, shall give notice loss. to the president and directors of the company at their office, to the end that the directors, their officers or agent, may examine and inquire into the same.

Sec. 17. And be it enacted, That no policy or contract of insurance shall be issued by the said Policy-how company until an amount of property, equal to the value of fifty thousand dollars, is offered and contracted to be insured.

SEC. 18. And be it enacted, That this act shall Effective. take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 171.

AN ACT to incorporate the Ancient Order of Hibernians in the State of Maryland.

Whereas an association exists in the State of Maryland under the title of the Ancient Order of Hibernians; and whereas said association Preamble. has applied for an act of incorporation in order that thereby its existence may be rendered more secure, and that it may be enabled to carry out with greater efficiency the important objects for which it was formed; therefore,
