act, and all laborers and other persons employed who under permanently or temporarily in and about the public buildings and grounds under the provisions of this act, shall be under the supervision of the superintendent of public buildings and grounds, and obey all orders and carry out all instructions by him given in relation to the care and protection of said public buildings and

grounds.

Sec. 5. And be it enacted, That the superintendent of public buildings and grounds shall, Execute bond. before entering upon the duties of his office, take the oath prescribed by the constitution of this state, and also execute a bond to the State of Maryland in the penalty of one thousand dollars, conditioned for the faithful discharge of the duties imposed upon him by this act, and for the delivery to his successor of all movable property belonging to the state, and said bond shall be filed with the secretary of state.

What is repealed.

SEC. 6. And be it enacted, That chapter fifteen of the acts of the general assembly passed at the session of eighteen hundred and sixty-one and eighteen hundred and sixty-two, and all laws and parts of laws inconsistent with the provisions of this act, be and the same are hereby repealed.

Effective.

SEC. 7. And be it enacted. That this act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.
