Chapter 177.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments section seventeen of chapter four hundred and forty-three of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, entitled "An act to amend the charter of Snow Hill, in Worcester County."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section seventeen of chapter four hundred and forty-three of the acts of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, entitled "An act to amend the charter of Snow Hill, in Worcester County," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows :

SEC. 17. *And be it enacted*, That the commissioners shall annually levy a tax for the expenses of the corporation upon the taxable property within the town limits, public and private securities and book accounts excepted, and the same shall be collected by a collector appointed by the said commissioners for the purpose, whose compensation for collecting said taxes shall not exceed five per centum, and who shall give bond in such amount as they shall prescribe, and hold his office during their pleasure, and the said collector, in collecting the said taxes, shall have full power to distrain for the same in the same manner as the collectors of state and county taxes now do, but the said tax shall not exceed twenty cents on the one hundred dollars for any one year.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall ^{Effective.} take effect from the date of its passage.
