AN ACT to establish and incorporate an asylum and training school for the feeble minded of the State of Maryland, and to make appropriation therefor.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Charles Ridgely Goodwin, Henry King, Levin F. Morris, Dr. John Morris, G.S. Griffith, James A. L. McClure, Thos. Hill, J. Clarence Lane, J. Walter Carpenter, Richard H. Edelen, Herman Stump, Charles B. Roberts, W. P. T. Turpin, Dr. John W. Dashiel, Dr. Richard Gundry, Dr. J. Pembroke Thom, Milton G. Urner, be and they are hereby made and constituted a body, politic and corporate, by and under the name of the visitors of the asylum and training school for the feeble minded of the State of Maryland, and by that name shall have perpetual succession, may sue and be sued in any court of this state, may have and use a common seal, and may at their pleasure alter and change what to purthese and hold sell, demise or dispose of any property, real, personal or mixed, as they shall judge to be most the same, and may purchase, hold and receive, beneficial and advantageous to the good and charitable ends and purposes of the institution, and receive donations and legacies of personal estate and money for the promotion of the objects of the institution.
