

**Chapter 191.**

AN ACT to authorize the governor to appoint two additional justices of the peace for Anne Arundel county.

**SECTION 1.** *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the governor be and he is hereby authorized and empowered to appoint one additional justice of the peace for election district number six, in Anne Arundel county, and one additional justice of the peace for the fifth election district of Anne Arundel county.

**SEC. 2.** *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

**Chapter 192.**

AN ACT to encourage the development of manufactures and manufacturing industry in Anne Arundel county, by adding additional sections to the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Anne Arundel County," sub-title "County Commissioners."

**SECTION 1.** *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the following sections be and they are hereby added to the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Anne Arundel County," under the sub-title "County Commissioners."

What and who to abate.

**SEC. ...** The county commissioners of Anne Arundel county are authorized and empowered, whenever it shall seem to them expedient for the encouragement of the growth and development of manufactures and manufacturing industry in said county, upon the application as hereinafter provided, of any individual, firm or corporation actually engaged in the business of manufacturing in said county, to abate all taxes for any year which may hereafter be levied for county or school purposes by authority
