

Chapter 26.

AN ACT to refund to Richard T. Browning a sum of money erroneously paid into the treasury of the state.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it appears by the books of the treasury department of the State of Maryland that Richard T. Browning has paid into the treasury of the state the sum of twenty-six dollars and fifty-four cents, in excess of the amount due by him for state taxes for eighteen hundred and eighty-five, for Garrett county; and whereas the treasurer and comptroller of the state have recommended the passage of a law refunding the said sum of money to said collector; therefore,

To whom paid

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the treasurer be and he is hereby directed, upon a warrant of the comptroller therefor, which he is authorized to draw, to pay Richard T. Browning the sum of twenty-six dollars and fifty-four cents, the same being an overpayment into the treasury of Maryland by the said Richard T. Browning, as collector of state and county taxes in Garrett county, for the year eighteen hundred and eighty-five.

Effective.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 27.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to pay the Electors of President and Vice President of the United States, in and for the State of Maryland, their officers and attendants.

Appropriation

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sum of five hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropri-
