

Chapter 202.

AN ACT to subscribe for a work entitled "The Law of Insolvency in Maryland," prepared by Clayton J. Purnell, and to appropriate a sum of money in payment therefor.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That three hundred copies of the work entitled "The Law of Insolvency in Maryland," prepared by Clayton J. Purnell, be and the same are hereby subscribed for, and the treasurer of the State of Maryland, upon the warrant of the comptroller, be and he is hereby directed to pay unto said Clayton J. Purnell the sum of nine hundred dollars in payment therefor when the said number of copies are completed and duly delivered to the librarian of the state.

Chapter 203.

AN ACT to prohibit the granting of license for the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer at any place within one mile, in any direction, of the Hannah Moore Academy.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That hereafter it shall not be lawful for the clerk of the circuit court for Baltimore county to issue a license to any person or persons to sell spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer nearer the Hannah Moore Academy than one mile in any direction.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
