

county for the use of public roads of said county.

Duty of constables.

SEC. 267. *And be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That it shall be the duty of the constables of the various districts of said county to see that section two hundred and sixty-five of this act is strictly enforced.

When not to apply.

SEC. 268. *And be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section two hundred and sixty-five of this act shall not apply to non-resident land owners and their relatives, nor shall said section apply to relatives or connections by marriage of *bona fide* residents of said county.

Effective.

SEC. 269. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 30.

AN ACT to amend section two of the act of eighteen hundred and eighty-six, chapter one hundred and sixty-two, entitled "An act for the more complete and efficient organization and discipline of the uniformed volunteers constituting a portion of the enrolled militia of the state," to be enlisted, organized and maintained as herein directed, and known as the "Maryland National Guard," by substituting the "Jackson Guards," of Harford county, in place of "The Williamsport Light Infantry" disbanded.
