Chapter 216.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, section twenty-two of article six of the Public General Laws, title "Apprentices."

Repealed and re-enacted.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That section twenty-two of article six of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Apprentices," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments, so as to read as follows:

(22). The directors of the Maryland Peniten-

tiary and the managers of the House of Correc-Bind apprention, or any three of them respectively, may bind as apprentices, until the age of twenty-one for males, and eighteen for females, the children of female convicts brought into the penitentiary or House of Correction, respectively, with their mothers, or born there during their time of service, and the managers of the House of Refuge shall have the same power over minors committed thereto; and all indentures or contracts so made shall be recorded in the orphans' court of Baltimore city within thirty days from the execution thereof.

Effective.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
