Chapter 31.

AN ACT to repeal sections one and two of an act of the General Assembly of Maryland passed at January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-two, entitled, "An act regulating fences in Wicomico county," as amended by the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at January session, eighteen hundred and seventy-four, chapter sixty-five, so far as the same applies to Trappe district in said county, otherwise known as election district Number seven, in said county.
