

sioners of said county, who shall apply said proceeds, under the direction of the said board of school commissioners, to the purchase of such lots and the erection and furnishing of such school buildings as said board of school commissioners may contract for, and to no other purpose.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall <sup>Effective.</sup> take effect from the date of its passage.

### Chapter 226.

AN ACT to incorporate the Loudon County and Frederick Bridge Company for the purpose of constructing a bridge at the Point of Rocks, in Frederick county, Maryland, across the Potomac river.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Joseph D. Baker, George William Smith, D. C. Winebrenner, David Lowenstein and E. B. Mercer be and they are hereby appointed commissioners for the purpose hereinafter mentioned, with power to supply any vacancy that may occur by death, resignation or otherwise; that is to say, they, or a majority of them, after twenty days' notice in one or more of the daily papers printed in the city of Frederick, Maryland, shall, or may open a book or books, at such place or places as they may designate, for raising subscriptions to construct a bridge at the Point of Rocks, in Frederick county, Maryland, opposite Potomac furnace, in Virginia, across the Potomac river; and thereupon they shall proceed to receive subscriptions for the capital stock of said company, which is hereby limited to thirty-five thousand dollars, to be divided into three hundred and fifty shares, of one hundred dollars each, which book or books shall be kept open until the whole number of shares have been subscribed.
