chosen from among their number, who shall appoint such officers and agents as he may deem necessary, and the said president shall be elected by a majority vote of the said trustees, and shall hold office for life.

Reservation.

SEC. 6. And be it enacted, That the General Assembly of Maryland reserves to itself the right to alter, amend or repeal this act, or any part thereof, at its pleasure.

Effective.

SEC. 7. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 33.

AN ACT authorizing and directing the state librarian to furnish certain books to the city library, at the city hall, in the city of Baltimore.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the state librarian be what to send and he is hereby directed to send to the city to city library. library, at the city hall, in the city of Baltimore, full sets of the laws, reports of the court of appeals, and other state publications, so far as the same may be done without detriment to the state library.

Effective.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
