Chapter 240.

AN ACT to pay Samuel Comegys, late collector of taxes for second district of Kent county, a sum of money for state taxes, paid by him into the treasury erroneously.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the comptroller be and he is hereby authorized and directed to pay to ^{Comptroller to pay.} Samuel Comegys, late collector, the sum of thirty dollars and forty cents, the same having been erroneously paid by him into the treasury, and certified as errors, insolvents and removals, and its repayment being recommended by the comptroller and the treasurer.

Chapter 241.

AN ACT to provide for the building of a school house for white children in the first district of Prince George's county, Maryland.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the county school commissioners of Price George's county be and they ^{Erect school house.} are hereby authorized and directed to appropriate the sum of five hundred dollars, or as much thereof as may be necessary out of the fund, for the support of white schools for said
