

county, to erect a school house for white children in Vansville district, near the point where the dividing line between said district and Laurel district intersects the Montgomery county line; provided one acre of ground, properly located for a school, shall be donated to said school commissioners as a school lot upon which to erect said school house.

Building committee. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the said school commissioners be and they are hereby constituted a building committee to contract for and superintend the erection of said school house.

Contract to lowest bidder. SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That the contract for the erection of the school house provided for in section one of this act shall be let to the lowest responsible bidder, and the same shall be completed on or before September the first, eighteen hundred and eighty-eight.

Effective. SEC. 4. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 242.

AN ACT to repeal section eighty-five of the act of assembly, passed at the January session eighteen hundred and seventy-four, chapter four hundred and eighty-three, entitled "Revenue and Taxes," relating to the taxation of savings banks, institutions and corporations, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Repealed, amended and re-enacted. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland.* That section eighty-five of the act of assembly, passed at the January session eighteen hundred and seventy-four, chapter four hundred and eighty-three, entitled "Revenue and Taxes," relating to the taxation of savings banks, institutions and corporations, be and the same is hereby repealed and amended, and re-enacted, so as to read as follows:
