

funds of said corporation shall be loaned to any officer or director thereof, it shall be the duty of the directors, at least as often as every twelve months, to make and declare such dividend of the interest and profits of said institution as will not impair the deposits thereof, or otherwise injure or affect the interest or credit of said institution, and the same to pay over to the depositors, or their legal representatives, within thirty days thereafter if called upon so to do, and no director or other officer shall be liable, in his person or property, for any debts, contracts or engagements, of said corporation, but the money, property, rights and credits, of said corporation, and nothing more, shall be liable for the same. Not liable.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. Effective.

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### Chapter 246.

AN ACT to repeal section two of chapter two hundred and fourteen of the acts of eighteen hundred and eighty, entitled "An act to repeal sections two and four of the act passed at the January session of eighteen hundred and seventy-six, chapter two hundred and seventy-seven," and to re-enact the same, with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section two of chapter two hundred and fourteen of the act of eighteen hundred and eighty, relating to the protection of oysters in the Synepuxent bay and its tributaries, be and the same is hereby repealed, and the following enacted in lieu thereof: Repealed and re-enacted.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the clerk of the circuit court for Worcester county may issue to any citizen of said county a license to take or catch oysters with rakes or tongs from the waters of Synepuxent bay, or its License for oysters.
