

Chapter 34.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact section thirty of article five of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Appeals and Errors," as amended by rule sixteen, framed and promulgated by the court of appeals.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section thirty of article five of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Appeals and Errors," as amended by rule sixteen, framed and promulgated by the court of appeals, be repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows :

Repealed and re-enacted.

30. No appeal shall be dismissed because the transcript shall not have been transmitted within the time prescribed, if it shall appear to the court of appeals that such delay was occasioned by the neglect, omission or inability of the clerk or appellee, but such neglect, omission or inability shall not be presumed, but must be shown by the appellant.

Neglect or omission must be shown.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 36.

AN ACT to add an additional section to article one of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Rules of Interpretation."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That article one of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland be amended by adding thereto the following :

Amended.

SEC. 12. The word person shall include corporation unless such a construction would be unreasonable.

What to include.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
