Chapter 251.

AN ACT to repeal section twenty-eight of article twenty of the Public Local Laws of Talbot county, sub-title "County Commissioners," and re-enact the same, with amendments.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General As-Repealed and sembly of Maryland, That section twenty-eight of article twenty of the Code of Public Local enacted. Laws of Talbot county, sub-title "County Commissioners," be and the same is hereby repealed, and the following enacted in lieu thereof:

(28). The said commissioners, or a majority of Appoint clerk them, shall appoint a clerk, who shall receive such compensation as they shall see proper to allow, not exceeding twelve hundred dollars per annum.
