AN ACT to repeal sections two hundred and ninety-five, two hundred and ninety-six, two hundred and ninety-seven, two hundred and ninety-eight, two hundred and ninety-nine, three hundred, three hundred and one, three hundred and two, three hundred and three, three hundred and four, three hundred and five, three hundred and six, three hundred and seven, three hundred and eight, three hundred and nine, three hundred and ten, three hundred and eleven, three hundred and twelve, and three hundred and thirteen of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Washington County," sub-title "Smithsburg," and to re-enact the same with amendments, and to add additional sections thereto.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That sections two hundred and ninety-five, two hundred and ninety-six, two hundred and ninety-seven, two hundred and ninety-eight, two hundred and ninety-nine, three hundred, three hundred and one, three hundred and two, three hundred and three, three hundred and four, three hundred and five, three hundred and six, three hundred and seven, three hundred and eight, three hundred and nine, three hundred and ten, three hundred and eleven, three hundred and twelve, and three hundred and thirteen of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Washington County," sub-title "Smithsburg," be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted, and additional sections added thereto, so as to read as follows :

Incorporated.

SEC. 295. The inhabitants of Smithsburg in Washington county, Maryland, are hereby created a corporation by the name of the "Burgess and Commissioners of Smithsburg," and by that name shall have perpetual succession, may sue and be sued, may have and use a common seal, and possess such other incidents and powers as attach by law to a municipal corpora-
