Chapter 316.

AN ACT to make the act of eighteen hundred and eighty-four, chapter five hundred and ten, entitled "An act to re-enact chapter three hundred and twenty-six of the acts of eighteen hundred and eighty, conferring additional jurisdiction on justices of the peace, applicable to Worcester county.

Made applicable.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That all the provisions of chapter five hundred and ten of the acts of eighteen hundred and eighty-four shall apply in all respects to Worcester county as fully and to the same extent as if said county had been included in said chapter five hundred and ten of the acts of eighteen hundred and eighty-four at the time it was passed.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
