

judge for his approval within three months from the date of its appointment.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That upon the adoption and approval of the plan or system of indexing authorized by the first section of this act, it shall be the duty of the clerk of said court forthwith to make and prepare for use in his office a new general index of all the land records of Harford county prior to the year eighteen hundred and eighty-eight, and to make and keep a general index upon the same plan for the year eighteen hundred and eighty-eight and succeeding years, said general index to be kept in well-bound books suitable for the purpose.

General index

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the committee so appointed as aforesaid shall, by and with the assent of the resident judges of the circuit court for Harford county, fix the compensation for said indexing of the land records as aforesaid up to the first day of January, eighteen hundred and eighty-eight, and that the sum so required to pay for said work shall be levied for and paid by the county commissioners of said county.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 324.

AN ACT to prohibit the granting of licenses for the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer in, at or near the town of Sparrow's Point, in the twelfth district of Baltimore county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That hereafter it shall not be lawful for the clerk of the circuit court for Baltimore county to issue license to any person or persons to sell spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer within the town of Sparrow's Point,

Unlawful to issue.
