for that purpose to be imposed on the occupants of the respective buildings, and collected as other May appoint a taxes are collected; provided, nevertheless, that scavenger. the owner or owners of property shall be responsible for said tax in case the same cannot be collected from the occupants thereof. And the council may pass suitable ordinances to enable such scavenger to remove all filth from the town. and may require of such scavenger a bond for the faithful performance of his duties; provided, Proviso. however, that said special tax shall not exceed fifty cents per month on any one house, to be paid by the owner or occupant thereof as aforesaid.

29. The council may pass suitable ordinances for the protection of the public buildings, Protection. churches, private buildings, trees and fencing from defacement or injury.

30. The mayor and council are authorized, empowered and required to pay for all work and improvements that have been done and made by pay. the commissioners for Rockville, not paid for at the time this charter shall take effect.

31. All existing ordinances of the town of Rockville shall remain in force until repealed or amended by the council; and all books, papers and property in possession of the commissioners for Rockville shall be delivered to the council when organized.
