and such other officers and agents as shall by it,

the said corporation, be deemed necessary.

SEC. 5. And be it enacted, That the said corporation may from time to time enact by-laws. Enact by-laws, to regulate the holding of corporate meetings, the election of officers, the employment of missionaries and agents, and all other matters proper to be regulated by by-laws; provided that such by-laws be not inconsistent with the laws of Maryland or of the United States, and a majority of the members of the corporation shall at any meeting thereof constitute a quorum for the election of officers, the enactment or repeal of by-laws, or the transaction of any other corporate business.

SEC. 6. And be it enacted, That the General Reserves right Assembly of Maryland reserves to itself the right to alter, amend or repeal this act at pleasure.

SEC. 7. And be it enacted, That this act shall Effective. take effect from the date of its passage.

Chapter 347.

AN ACT to prevent the sale of fermented or spirituous liquors or lager beer within one mile of Phœnix factory, in Baltimore county.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That it shall not be lawful for the clerk of the circuit court for Baltimore county to issue license to any person or persons, firm or company, to sell any fermented or spirituous liquors or lager beer within one mile of the main factory building at Phoenix factory, Baltimore county.

SEC. 1. And be it enacted, That any person or Subject to fine persons, firm or company, convicted of selling any fermented or spirituous liquors or lager beer within one mile of the main factory building at Phœnix, Baltimore county, shall be subject to a fine of not less than twenty dollars nor more

Unlawful.
