**Report and account.**  
 SEC. 8. *And be it enacted,* That the treasurer and collector of taxes for Prince George's county shall report and account to the county commissioners for all taxes placed in his hands for collection, and shall hold all moneys collected for county purposes subject to order of county commissioners.

**Repealed.**  
 SEC. 9. *And be it enacted,* That all laws or parts of laws inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

**Effective.**  
 SEC. 10. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

**Chapter 352.**

AN ACT for the better protection of game and wild water-fowl in Charles county, and to prevent the shooting, taking or killing of same by non-residents without license.

**Unlawful to shoot, etc.**  
 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That it shall not be lawful for any person in Charles county to shoot, kill or catch, or in any manner to entrap any partridge or quail in said county between the twenty-fourth day of December and the first day of November; nor any woodcock, between the twenty-fourth day of February and the fourth day of July; nor any rabbit, between the fifteenth day of January and the fifteenth day of October of each year.

**Penalty for violation.**  
 SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That any person violating the preceding section shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and, on conviction thereof before any justice of the peace in said county, shall pay a fine of five dollars for each partridge, woodcock or rabbit shot or taken; one-half of said fine to be paid to the informer, and the remainder as hereinafter directed; and on failure to pay said fine, shall be committed to
