

Fine. of said county of gunning, or employing any one else to gun within the limits of said county without a license so to do, shall be fined the sum of thirty dollars for the first and for every subsequent offence; and on failure to pay said fine the offender shall be confined in the county jail for thirty days.

Unlawful to ship. SEC. 5. *And be it enacted.* That it shall not be lawful for any person to ship, or attempt to ship out of said county, at any season of the year any partridges, quail, woodcock or rabbit that have been shot or trapped in said county into any other county or state; and that any person violating the provisions of this section by selling or shipping game out of said county shall be fined the sum of five dollars for every partridge, quail, woodcock or rabbit so shipped; and persons convicted before any justice of the peace for said county failing to pay said fine shall be confined in the county jail for thirty days.

Chapter 357.

AN ACT to encourage the development of manufactures and manufacturing industry in Wicomico county by adding additional sections to the Public Local Laws of Wicomico county sub-title "County Commissioners."

Additional sections. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the following sections be and they are hereby added to the Public Local Laws of Wicomico county, under sub-title "County Commissioners."

May exempt. SEC. ... The county commissioners of Wicomico county are authorized and empowered, whenever it shall seem to them expedient for the encouragement of the growth and development of manufactures and manufacturing industry in said county, upon the application as hereinafter provided of any individual, firm or corporation actually engaged in the business of manufactur-
